**Role Summary:**

The Pilbara Advisory Committee exists to provide key community engagement activities and advice for the Blacksmith Project in the communities of the Town of Port Hedland, Shire of Ashburton and City of Karratha.

- Act as a touch point for the local community with regard to the Project.
- Enable grassroots engagement with and support for local clubs/organisations.
- Build third-party advocacy for the Project to assist with our approvals and permitting processes.

- Strong connection to the Pilbara community, with understanding of the region and its needs.
